- In school sessions are seen as being preventative
- Focus on building conflict capacity
- Run Labs in the summer to allow students to develop programs to support peers.
- Book recommendation "Becoming Kin: An Indigenous Call to Unforgetting the Past and Reimagining Our Future" by Patty Krawec
- Support for youth from beginning to the conclusion of making amends

- Community Service partners are important to offer options for making amends
- Apology letter is named "Accountability letter" which has more ownership of the issue
- Regular meetings with the RCMP watches keeps a positive relationship

Members had the opportunity to ask questions and share ideas with respect to youth in schools and in the community.
